A call for Musicians!

Tell it on Tuesday producers are looking for musical artists who are:

- Polished performance-wise
- Fairly low-tech

And who have:

- A 40-45 minute repertoire ready
- An easy-to-strike set-up

More info about performances:

- The music is the opening act for an evening of storytelling. We have a steady audience of 50-90 locals. You'd be playing for the half hour before the storytelling begins, so people would be coming in and finding their seats and may be socializing.
- We would require the musician(s) to arrive at 6:30pm on the night of the performance (almost always the last Tuesday of the month) to do a quick stage set-up, and sound-check if necessary, then start playing at 7pm.
- Musicians should have a 40-45 minute repertoire ready, as often we start 5-10 minutes after the 7:30 story-start time, to allow audience a few more minutes to find a seat.
- Musicians are welcome to sell CDs of their work in the lobby of the theater during intermission.
- This is a voluntary performance – no pay. All of us are volunteering our time and talent, performers and producers alike. The audience pays a nominal entrance fee that goes toward paying for printed materials, outreach, the technician, insurance and the space rental.
